Klassik Engerwitzdorf, Memminger Master Concerts, Music in the Einsiedeln monastery, Abonnement Concert Györ and the "Sunday Matinées" at the Brucknerhaus Linz).

After a major success in the concert series Sunday Matinées in the Brucknerhaus Linz in 2002, the **Festival Sinfonietta Linz** is now a fixed point in the series.

The New Year concerts of classical waltzes directed by Lui Chan on the violin are also a great hit, both at home and abroad.
